

**Responsibilities of the
Native America Village Director**

The Native America Village Director is responsible to the Program Director for the effective instruction of specialized Native America skills and of any merit badges assigned by the Program Director. The Native America Village Director must possess organizational and managerial skills; creativity and originality; and a desire to work with youth of Boy Scout age.

The Native America Village Director must:

1. Be at least 18 years old
2. Possess or be willing to obtain a current registration in the Boy Scouts of America
3. Have a strong Boy Scouting background & with the Order of the Arrow

The Native America Village Director is further encouraged to obtain a certification in American Red Cross Standard First Aid or its equivalent.

The Native America Village Director is further responsible for:

1. Setting up an area to which Scouts and Leaders may come for instruction in the following skills and their related merit badges & Activities
 - a) Merit Badge
 - b) Archeology
 - c) Indian Lore
 - d) Fly Fishing
 - e) Fishing
 - f) Order of the Arrow , Activities in camp
 - g) Dancing
 - h) Drumming
 - i) Regalia Workshop
2. Training and supervising the work of the Native America Village Staff
3. Making available and encouraging troops, patrols, and older Scouts to participate in special activities at the Native America Village
4. Helping unit leaders to become aware of the Native America Village program possibilities available both in and out of Camp.
5. Maintaining up-to-date and accurate inventories of all equipment used in the Native America Village.
7. Ensuring the counselors-in-training assigned to the Native America Village receive meaningful and relevant experiences
8. Turning in records of merit badge participation, badge completion to the Program Director by 9:00p.m. each Thursday
9. Assisting in the general Camp program in anyway possible, and completing any assignments given by the Program Director or the Camp Director
10. Working to maintain the morale of other Staff members assigned to the Native America Village.
11. Writing a report on the Native America Village, and turning it in to the Program Director before leaving Camp. This report should document the extent of use of the program and suggestions for improvements.
12. Abiding by the Camp rules set forth in the *Staff Understandings/Policies* and the *Staff Guide*.
