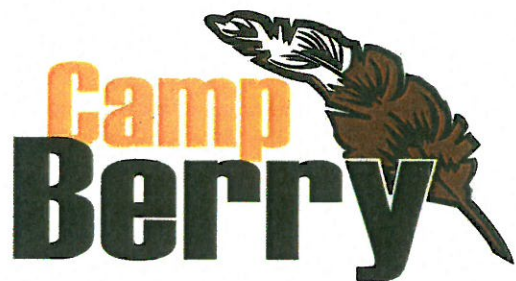

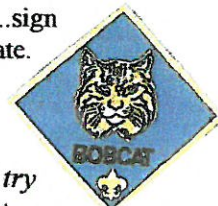


Join Cub Scouts.....How to Become a Bobcat

In order to become a Cub Scout....you must first earn your **BOBCAT RANK !!!!!!!**

Parents.... Your son needs to learn and demonstrate the following seven requirements. (He may have help, if needed, as he recites the Oath and the Law) When he has completed all seven requirements ..sign below. He must present this form to his Cubmaster at his first pack meeting to be awarded a certificate. His Bobcat badge will be presented to him at the second pack meeting.

1. Learn and say the Scout Oath

On my honor I will do my best
To do my duty to God and my country
and to obey the Scout Law;
To help other people at all times;
To keep myself physically strong,
mentally awake, and morally straight

*In the Scout Oath you say you will try
hard to practice your religious duties.
You will stand up for your country;
You will be honest, fair and obey the
Scout Law.*

2. Learn and say the Scout Law

A scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful,
friendly, courteous, kind, obedient,
cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and
reverent.

*The Scout Law has 12 points. Each
is a goal for every Scout. He does his
best to live up to the Law every day.
It is not always easy to do, but a
Scout always tries.*

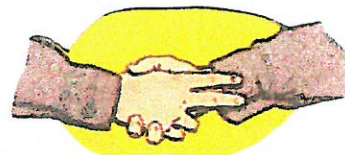
3. Show and explain the Cub Scout Sign..

Make the sign with your right hand,
Separate your first two fingers and hold
your other fingers down with your thumb.
Hold your arm straight up above your head
*The raised fingers stand for the Scout Oath
and the Scout Law.*



4. Show and explain the Cub Scout Handshake

When you shake hands with another scout,
place your first two fingers of the right hand
on the side of the other boy's wrist.
*This means that you help each other to remember
and obey the Scout Oath and Scout Law.*



5. Say the Cub Scout Motto.... "DO YOUR BEST"

A motto is a guiding principle and a rule for living.

6. Show and explain the Cub Scout Salute

Salute with your right hand. Hold your first two fingers
close together, hold your other two fingers down with
your thumb. Touch your fingertips to your cap. If you
are not wearing a cap, touch your right eyebrow.
*You salute the flag to show respect for your country.
Always use the salute when you are in uniform.*



7. With your parent or guardian, complete the exercises in the pamphlet "How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse:" A Parent's Guide

BOBCAT BADGE

IMPORTANT FACTS

“One of the most important parts of earning BOBCAT is understanding that all members of the Boy Scouts of America believe in, live by, and often repeat the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. We learn those words and believe in them as a way to live our lives and be good members of our families, our communities, and the Boy Scouts of America.”

Program Focus: (1) Learn and say the Scout Oath, with help if needed; (2) Learn and say the Scout law, with help if needed; (3) Show the Cub Scout sign. Tell what it means; (4) Show the Cub Scout handshake. Tell what it means. (5) Say the Cub Scout motto. Tell what it means. (6) Show the Cub Scout salute. Tell what it means. (7) With your parent or guardian, complete the exercises in the pamphlet *How to Protect Your Children From Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide*.

How to Find: BOBCAT is the only rank that does not have its own book for reference. The requirements for BOBCAT will be found on page 16 in each of the handbooks for Tiger, Wolf, and Bear, and on page 22 of the Webelos handbook.

Important Facts: (1) BOBCAT is the first badge that can be earned in Cub Scouting. (2) BOBCAT must be earned prior to any other scouting rank. (3) BOBCAT is the only rank that can be earned regardless of the age or grade level of the scout. (4) A Cub cannot earn or receive his Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, or Arrow of Light until he has completed the BOBCAT requirement and earned his BOBCAT badge.

We need to encourage participation and accomplishment!!!! The boys are very excited about Scouting!! Receiving an advancement as soon as possible adds to that excitement!!!

Immediate Recognition: (1) The BOBCAT badge should be awarded to the scout as soon as he completes the requirements. (2) The expectation is that the boys can normally earn their BOBCAT well within the first month of becoming a new Cub Scout.

Recap: The BOBCAT is NOT a part of any other rank badge, and is earned prior to any other badge, regardless of the age or grade level of the scout. It is found in the front section of each ranking book. It can be earned by a scout, regardless of their age or grade level. The Scout should understand and be able to perform the handshake, sign, and salute and have an understanding of the Oath and Law for their respective age level.

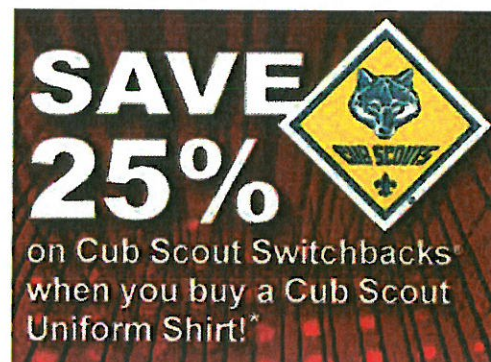

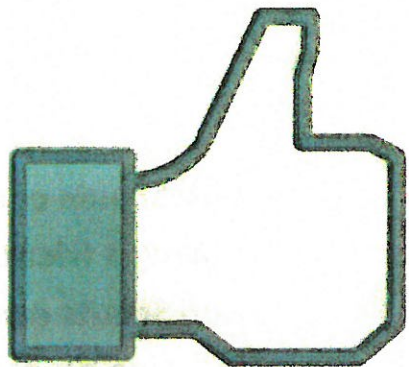

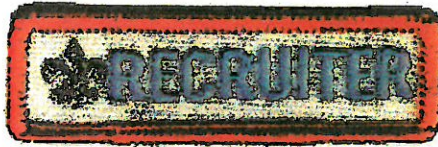
