

Deputy Lyons has been the Post Advisor for the Paulding County Sheriff Explorers for three years. When asked why Exploring, Lyons said, "The number one reason I am in Explorers is to get the youth involved. I believe Exploring is a great start for youth interested in a career in any branch of law enforcement. I currently have Explorers who are interested in Corrections, Dispatch and Road positions as well as one who is wanting to become a prosecuting attorney." When asked about his favorite memory, Lyons harkened back to the Paulding County Fair, where the Explorers raise money with a Dunk a Deputy, dunk tank, "As you can imagine, this is always a competition to see who can raise the most money. Sheriff Landers has been the leader for all three years," said Lyons. Bill went on to say, "There is a lot of knowledge available to Explorers that is certainly beneficial and will give them a head start in this career field."
