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## Pack/Troop/Crew Responsibility

- Set up a station and provide staff to run your area. This could be a Spook, Craft or Hospitality Station. Sections will be assigned by Spook Chairs on a first request/first received basis. (Hint register early)
  - Mo guns or knives, (plastic axes-acceptable)
  - Chain saws WITHOUT CHAIN are permitted
  - If flag is raised by participant, adapt scariness
- Scout Uniform or Halloween Costume
- Sections will be judged by the participants for originality, creativeness, theme appropriate and FUN.
  - Must provide box (shoe box size) decorated for participants to drop their vote into.
- Awards will be given out Sunday Morning at Leader/SM/Advisor & SPL/President Breakfast
- Provide Medical forms
