Unit Renewal Timeline

- October 2025:
 Renewal opens
- November 2025:
 Early submission
 encouraged
- December 1, 2025: Deadline for renewal submission
- January 2026: New program year begins



Unit Renewal Process

- Log in to online recharter system
- Update roster (youth + adult leaders)
- Collect fees (national + council)
- \$125/Youth
- \$65/Adult
- \$100/Unit
- Submit paperwork digitally
- Confirm and print charter certificate

Membership Renewal

- Verify all youth and adult members are reregistered
- Encourage family participation
- Assists with Scouts who need financial aid
- Stress importance of Safe Scouting compliance



Key Requirements

- Background checks for adult leaders
- Youth Protection Training (valid through May 31,2026)
- Unit leadership positions filled (Scoutmaster, Committee Chair, etc.)

National Unit Renewal paid

- Insurance coverage for members
- Training & leadership resources
